

Evaluation

- Three Staff Development Days were held this school year with the objectives of enhancing teachers' professional skills and reinforcing the harmonious relationship among all teachers.
- The 1st Staff Development Day led by Principal CHIN Yiu-ming focused on the elements, the theories and the practicability of "What Makes a Good/Caring Lesson". The Physical Education and Visual Arts Departments demonstrated how to lead a good/caring lesson.
- The 2nd Staff Development Day was comprised of the Teacher Symposium organized by the Education Bureau and the in-house training focusing on executing invitational education to unleash students' potentials.
- The 3rd Staff Development Day was comprised of the sharing on supporting students with social, behavioural and emotional difficulties by EDB Educational Psychologist, the sharing on the implementation of national and security education through thematic art creation activities by Cheung Chau Government Secondary School and the sharing on values education and character building of students by Tin Shui Wai Government Secondary School.
- In addition, the school invited Tin Shui Wai Government Secondary School to share effective eLearning strategies in self-regulatory learning in the new learning and teaching era.
- All teachers contributed to reflect on and revise the strategies for the Annual School Plan 2021-22 to foster continuous improvements in learning and teaching and students' whole person development.
- All teaching staff considered the activities of the Staff Development Days constructive in improving their learning and teaching efficacy.
- Many positive responses have been received from teacher participants with genuine reflection and ways for improvement.

Ways Forward

- Professional sharing within subject departments and across disciplines will be reinforced.
- The school will invite experts from other government schools, tertiary education institutions and the Education Bureau to share learning and teaching pedagogies and professional experience so as to foster continuous staff development.

Discipline, Values Education and Healthy School Programme

Evaluation

- The Discipline Team has been promoting and emphasizing self-discipline of students through not only the Punishment Point System but also the Merit System throughout the years. Students are awarded merits with regard to their performance in diligence, conduct, school services and extra-curricular activities. With the close collaboration with Class Teachers and parents, such as regular Class Teacher Meetings, case meetings with Class Teachers, Parents' Days and Parents' Talks, the Discipline Team implements plans and measures to encourage students' positive behaviour and nurtures them to be responsible and respectful to peers, teachers, parents and society.
- The Discipline Team attaches great importance to cooperation with other working teams in school. The Counselling Team, School Social Workers, Whole School Student Support Team and Educational Psychologist are our indispensable partners.
- Through close collaboration with these essential parties, the implementation of various preventive and remedial measures can be expedited and more efficacious. Our discipline teachers are altruistic to spend their time and efforts communicating with colleagues and other important stakeholders for the betterment and development of students.
- The Prefect Board is our strong and influential support. They are formed in compliance with an impartial, objective selection policy with the involvement of our Principal, Assistant Principals and all teaching staff. Our prefects have played their roles as a bridge between school authorities and pupils. They are also tasked with the responsibilities of organizing activities in collaboration with teachers and maintaining order in the school. They are the role models with a high reputation among teachers and students. They are well equipped with different skills acquired in our training programmes and our discipline teachers' strenuous effort to foster the growth of prefects.

Ways Forward

- As junior form students, especially the newly joined Form One students, in the notion that they face more challenges regarding their studies and interpersonal relationships, more regular level assemblies and case meetings will be arranged for class teachers to equip them with manifold support strategies.
- Special programmes will be held to promote responsibility, respect and inclusiveness among our students.

Guidance, Counselling and Life Education

Evaluation

To enhance students' whole-person development, a Whole School Approach is adopted. All school personnel work together to create a positive and caring learning environment for students to grow with enhanced self-esteem and to realize their potentials.

The Counselling Committee coordinates counselling services and interventions effectively and is working in collaboration with the School Social Workers and the School-based Educational Psychologist to provide professional support to meet the specific personal, social and emotional needs of every student.

To promote a positive and harmonious school culture, diversified and dynamic programmes such as Big Brother Big Sister Scheme, S1 Orientation, Good People Good Deeds Recognition Scheme, Emotion Control Training Group, and the Guardian Angel Programme were organized for students.

To inculcate the virtues of respect and care in students and to enhance their resilience and self-aware personalities, the Counselling Committee offered a wide range of activities, including I Can Do It Goal Setting Workshops, Leadership Training Workshops for Student Counsellors, S1 Growth workshops and some interactive / reflective activities such as Archery Tag, Zentangle Class, Writing Thanksgiving cards to parents and Fund Raising for the Community Chest by selling flowers.

The support given to students helped them develop self-confidence and positive attitudes. These programmes also enhanced students' interpersonal communication skills and sense of belonging to the school. The Student Counsellors also found the training workshops helpful in developing their potential, enhancing their self-esteem and thus were more prepared to meet the challenges in the future.

Ways Forward

Under the framework of the Whole School Approach to Guidance, co-ordination among the Counselling Committee, all teachers, other functional teams and the Social Workers will be further strengthened to help students develop into whole persons.

Preventive and developmental guidance programmes will continue to foster students' positive values and facilitate their holistic growth.

The Committee will continue to cooperate with the School-based Educational Psychology and the School Social Workers to provide support in catering for students' diverse personal developmental, educational and psychological needs. Tailored training groups and workshops to meet students' specific needs will be continued.

The mission of the Student Association (SA) is to connect students to the school and empower students with the spirit of democracy. The "one student one vote" principle that governs the Annual SA Election is for all students to experience and respect democracy by exercising their rights and fulfilling their responsibilities as a school member.

- Apex, the Student Association 2020-2021, won the election and led the Association to serve all STMGSS students throughout the school year. The SA headed by Apex was more than just a student body that improves student welfare by providing sales of exercise books, stationeries and sanitary items. It had a more important role to play in nurturing student leaders and providing them with a platform to organize student-led activities on and off campus. Apex organized activities including SA Election Forum, SA Election Polling Day and SA Inauguration Ceremony cum AGM. Apex also proposed and had successfully implemented to change the school rule and allow schoolmates to wear PE uniform to go to school.

Career and Life Planning Education

Evaluation

- To align with the School Programme Plan 2020-21, Major Concern (2): To develop positive characters and attitudes of students, thus promoting a caring culture, various CLP Education Training Workshops were held for S1 and S2. Students acquired better self-understanding and could establish positive attitudes. They had acquired strategies to achieve their goal in life planning and understood the importance of interests towards life planning and their relationships.
- To equip students with CLP knowledge and skills through group interviews for S3 to S5 and individual interview for S6: S3 students reviewed that they would consider their personalities, abilities, interest, their aspirations for tertiary education, and career prospect (like promotion and salaries) when they were choosing their Senior Secondary Elective Subjects in S4. S6 students were engaged in the discussion of their further studies plan and study strategies in the interview. They gave measures to fine-tune their life planning and re-prioritize their JUPAS programme choices.
- To broaden the knowledge of students of further educational and careers opportunities with CLP Education Workshops: S3 students learnt about the multiple pathways after completing their senior secondary studies and therefore they would be more serious about choosing S4 elective subjects as they knew about the relationship between these subjects and tertiary education. S4 students reviewed that they chose the multiple pathways and would attain their goals when they considered their life planning.
- To equip parents with the knowledge in CLP education, senior secondary curriculum, JUPAS Application and Post-S6 opportunities by Parents' Talk: Parents knew more about the latest CLP information and multiple pathways. They also learnt how to understand and assist their children in their future studies and career planning.

Ways Forward

- To help junior secondary students identify their interests and abilities, encourage them to set study goals, and guide them in connecting their career aptitudes with subject selection, thereby better equipping these students for senior secondary education.
- To help senior secondary students reflect on and review their interests, abilities and aspirations
 for a better understanding of themselves, so that they could set medium and long term goals for
 studies or career development.

National Security Education

Evaluation

- To foster students' positive attitudes towards national security, the National Security Education Committee was established to coordinate the school's KLAs, subject departments and functional teams.
- The flag-raising ceremony and the "Speech under the National Flag" are whole-school weekly events and are held on special function days such as the School Commencement /Closing Ceremonies and National Security Education Day.
- In response to the National Security Education Day, an opening ceremony was held and various activities were organized. Posters about national security education were put up on school boards, and stickers and bookmarks were distributed.
- Diversified activities and competitions were organized to cultivate the virtues of respect and enhance the understanding of different dimensions of National Security, such as National Security Board Design Competition, Hong Kong Macao Students Online Communication, Digital Design and Painting Competition and 2021 National Security Day Online Competition.
- To enable students to acquire desirable moral and national qualities, to enrich their lives and to facilitate their identity-building in the domains of family, society, the country and the world, a series of activities / programmes were organized to cultivate positive values and attitudes among them. These included Healthy School Program, Understanding our Basic Law workshops, Sister School Scheme and some parental education programmes.
- The Discipline & Values Education Committee and the Guidance, Counselling & Life Education Committees consistently encouraged students to be good citizens obeying rules and laws and reminded students of the consequences of breaking rules and laws.

Ways Forward

- More opportunities will be offered to students to learn and reflect on their personal development, social and world issues so that they will be concerned about society, the nation and the world.
- To nurture students to be good citizens who have a strong sense of nationhood and national identity, are aware of their responsibilities to safeguard national security, show respect for and abide by the laws, more emphasis will be placed on promotion of national security education within and beyond the classrooms via individual subjects, cross-curricular topics in moral and civic education, and organising life-wide learning activities.
- The curricula contents of relevant key learning areas will be enriched to raise students' awareness of national security so that they will become good citizens who have a sense of national identity, respect for and abide by the laws.

For instance, student learnt that Amazon rainforest wildfires have devastating consequences and preserving the Amazon rainforest is of global importance.
- A series of activities were planned to cultivate students' positive values and attitudes: S1-2 Mainland Exchange Programme, S1-3 Class Periods about the Basic Law, S3 Visit to the Greater Bay Area on the Life-wide Learning Day, Top Ten News Election and News Commentary Competition. These activities could enable students to acquire desirable moral and national qualities, enriching their life and facilitating their identity-building in the domains of family, society, the country and the world. Regrettably, the events had to be cancelled owing to class suspension.

Ways Forward

- Emphasis will continue to be placed on Basic Law education in the coming school year.
- More activities will be organised to nurture students to become proactive and responsible citizens, who can make rational judgments and respect human rights, equality, democracy and the rule of law.
- More emphasis will be put on cultivating students' national and civic values when arranging "Speech under the National Flag"

Health and Sex Education

Evaluation

- The mission of the Health and Sex Education Team is to promote health and sex education in school so that students can have good physical, mental and social health. In addition, they will be taught about issues pertaining to personal growth and development, so as to make wise judgment on sex-and-gender- related matters.
- We organized game booth 「愛 健康」飲食常識挑戰站 in Open Day to promote the healthy lifestyles and won the First runner-up in The Best Courtesy/Service Award and the Second runner-up in The Best Theme Award among all game boothes.
- In collaboration with the Home Economics Department, activities like Joyful fruit day, Fun Fruit Quiz, online cooking classes, etc. were held for students of different levels. These activities, aimed at educating students on the importance of balanced diet to health.
- All in all, many health and sex education activities were held throughout the year via various channels such as board displays, game stalls, talks and class periods.

Ways Forward

• As the majority of participating students and teachers agreed that the activities were useful in improving students' mental health, we will continue to make use of various resources to develop students' positive attitude in life. More attention will be paid to improve the planning and organization of the activities in order to suit the needs of the students.



健康及性教育組一健康教育快樂人生

Environmental Education

Evaluation

- A refrigerator and a steam cabinet have been installed in the covered playground for students to freeze and steam their lunch boxes during the lunch time. The installation of these machines can encourage students to prepare their healthy lunch and reduce the usage of plastic box. Also, a food waste decomposer has been installed for turning food waste into useful resources. This equipment is mainly for educational purpose which can promote the green living style in school and generate the organic fertilizer for the plants in the school campus.
- An interactive drama show performed by Theatre in the Dark was held in the middle of October for S4 students. This show delivered a message to the students to minimize the usage of plastic in daily life. Most of students showed positive feedback and agreed that the activity could increase their environmental awareness.

Ways Forward

- Emphasis will continue to be placed on the promotion of green living style in school.
- More activities such as talk and in-school exhibition will be organized to deliver the concept of sustainable development in urban planning.
- More emphasis will be put on cultivating students' environmental awareness by joining the school environmental ambassador program organized by the Environmental Protection Department.










2021 JUPAS Offer Results





Major Concern 1: To enhance learning and teaching effectiveness

Achievements and Evaluation

Teachers utilized the combined face-to-face and Zoom mode to enhance the learning and teaching effectiveness.

At Subject Department Level:

Strategy 1: Remedial classes of Chinese, English and Mathematics are implemented in Junior forms & S5.

Students' learning attitude has improved with a higher passing rate in Examinations and Uniform Tests. It was agreed that a smaller class size gave teachers' opportunities to have more time to cater for learners' diversity.

Strategy 2: Organize learning enhancement courses for students with higher learning abilities

Students were also invited to take part in various external competitions, such as verse speaking and drama competitions while project-based learning was incorporated in students' learning in junior forms.

Collaboration occured among various departments, like Economics, Life & Society, Visual Arts, Liberal Studies, Mathematics and English in lesson planning, while co-teaching was practiced in the 2nd term. Presentation and peer evaluation were conducted in the lessons.

Strategy 3: Establish a 'Post-Marking Evaluation' mechanism

Teachers made use of the marker's report for examinations to adjust teaching strategy. Graded worksheets and tailor-made materials were prepared for students. Students could complete assigned tasks and learning effectiveness was raised.

At Teachers' Level:

Strategy 1 : Design at least one 'good lesson'

During the Teachers' Professional Development, lesson plans for 'what makes a good lesson' were made by various subject departments. IT was widely used in teaching with online resources like YouTube videos and apps like schology, edpuzzle, and so on to promote interaction among students. Various 'good lessons' were implemented in the 2nd term.

Strategy 2: Conduct peer observation of lessons and share views after peer observation.

Peer observation has been carried out and professional sharing sessions were conducted in Subject Departments with sharing points written down in the minutes which built up knowledge management.

At Students' Level:

Strategy 1: Incorporate study methods in the junior secondary subject curriculum

The use of Google Classroom and e-Class becomes a common practice, while online reading is promoted. Revision notes with writing genre and format were supplied and discussed and most subject departments offered S6 pre-mock and post-mock examination. Teaching ideas and questioning techniques were exchanged among teachers and peer-focused lesson observations were conducted among teachers in various departments in the 2^{nd} term.

Way Forward

The objective of "what makes a good lesson" was fulfilled this year and the effectiveness of learning and teaching was enhanced. Hence, questioning techniques, teaching strategies and appropriate feedback to students should be emphasized in order to guide students to have better analytical skills and discussions on subject knowledge in year 2021-22.

Major Concern 2: To promote a caring culture, and further develop positive character and attitudes of students

Achievements and Evaluation

Even though quite a lot of activities could not be organized or conducted in Zoom mode, teachers fully utilized the resumed face-to-face lessons to accomplish the tasks set.

Strategy 1: Promote a comprehensive and effective incentive scheme in all subject departments, functional teams, clubs and societies so that all students work together to create a positive school culture.

It was not fully implemented as teachers prioritized the teaching and learning of subject matters in the limited face-to-face lessons. Yet positive school culture was promoted in subjects. For example, thematic learning activities in English developed positive values in students. S1 students shared their positive values in Life & Society lessons.

Strategy 2: Cooperate in organising co-curricular activities in different subject departments, functional teams, clubs and societies to assist students in self-understanding, appreciating themselves, creating a positive self-image, developing a full range of positive character and attitudes, social skills, and establishing harmonious interpersonal relationships.

It was implemented satisfactorily through the collaboration of teams. Students were inculcated with the positive values in various occasions through the year. They were inculcated with values of honesty and law compliance. Over 70% of students and teachers claimed that they understood how to adopt a healthy lifestyle. 78% of students concerned learnt how to cope with emotion. The atmosphere of love and gratitude also extended to families of students through activities like "Thanksgiving Cards" & "Celebrating Mother's Day". Our school has developed an atmosphere of love, harmony & positive culture.

Strategy 3: Design and implement student-oriented activities, so that more chances can be created to enable students to succeed, thus stimulating students' interest in learning and enhancing their self-esteem and self-confidence.

It was implemented satisfactorily even though under the pandemic situation. Student-oriented activities such as Wacky Olympics and various competitions were organized and it was observed that students have improvement in self-esteem and confidence.


Way Forward

The strategies were appropriate and should have been implemented more successfully if there had not been an outbreak of COVID-19. Strengthening or modification of the strategies for the next year is recommended.

It is suggested to continue Strategies 2 and 3 next year. Strategy 2 should be strengthened. More collaboration between different subject departments, functional teams, clubs and societies is recommended to promote cohesion and sense of belonging among students towards the school.
