




You're Halfwal





在此衷心感謝廖潔凝老師的用心帶領,從您與學生亦師亦友的相處我學習到認真做事、投入 玩樂;您對戲劇的熱誠、投入的時間和心血感染到我也為自己的目標奮力;您的領導和信任讓我 們明白團隊合作的重要。多謝您今我的中學生涯難忘、獲益良多。


